## NEUROLOGY EXPERIENCE

My Medical training is done at T.N.Medical College and B.Y.L. Nair Ch.

Hospital. I did my training under Dr. A.B.Shah. It is one of the busiest and largest neurology department.

- As a senior resident in Neurology and General Medicine, I have taught clinical medicine, clinical neurology and investigational procedures to undergraduates, postgraduates, nursing staffs and paramedical personnel.
- Have trained and assisted interns, junior residents in ward management, intensive care, electrophysiology, evoked potential, electroencephalography, plasmapheresis etc.

### Teaching Experiences

I have worked as a Lecturer in Dept. of Medicine at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Nagpur from January 1999 to May 1999.

I have worked as a clinical **electrophysiologist at Sir H.N. Hospital, Mumbai** after completion of my DM course. I have performed about 1500 EMG studies during my tenure of about three years.

### **Stroke and Interventional Neurology**

After that I have done a fellowship in Interventional Neurology at pune with Dr. Anand Alurkar, one of the busiest interventional Neurologist (He has done maximum number of cases of intracranial stenting in Maharashtra ).
